

Cellular therapy studies in the Blood and Marrow Transplant Clinical Trials Network

This report outlines the process by which cellular therapy studies can be submitted, reviewed, and implemented by the Blood and Marrow Transplant Clinical Trials Network (BMT CTN). The BMT CTN infrastructure can facilitate trials for innovative multi-institutional Phase II trials of cell therapy relevant to blood and marrow transplantation. Investigators interested in exploring the feasibility of conducting a novel cell therapy trial in the BMT CTN should submit a proposal to the BMT CTN Data and Coordinating Center. Investigators are also strongly encouraged to consider using the Production Assistance for Cellular Therapies, a National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute-supported cell processing program.
